### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibition of Traffic (Belfast) (Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1985.

### Revocation

2. The Prohibition of Traffic (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland)  $1981(\mathbf{b})$  is revoked.
