Control of Traffic (Newcastle) (Revocation) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1985

<i>Coming into operation</i>	29th June 1985

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Traffic (Newcastle) (Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985 and shall come into operation on 29th June 1985.

Revocation

2. The Control of Traffic (Newcastle) Order (Northern Ireland) 1984(b) is hereby revoked.

The effect of this Order is to permit vehicles to make a left hand turn into South Promenade, Newcastle, at its northern junction with Harbour Road and to make a right hand turn into South Promenade at its southern junction with Harbour Road.
