## ROAD AND RAILWAY TRANSPORT

The Road Transport Licensing (Authorisation of International Journeys) (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985

Made 30th January 1985 1st April 1985 Coming into operation

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 56(1) and (5) of the Finance Act 1973(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and with the consent of the Department of Finance and Personnel(b) hereby makes the following regulations:

# Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Road Transport Licensing (Authorisation of International Journeys) (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1985.

#### **Amendments**

- 2. In regulation 4 of the Road Transport Licensing (Authorisation of International Journeys) (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1984(c)—
  - (a) in paragraph (a) for the words "£39" substitute the words "£50"; and
  - (b) in paragraph (b) for the words "£3.25" substitute the words "£4.20".

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Road Transport Licensing (Authorisation of International Journeys) (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1984 by increasing the fees for period permits (permits allowing Northern Ireland road freight operators to carry goods for reward from Northern Ireland to the Republic of Ireland and from the Republic of Ireland to Northern Ireland):

- (a) from £39 to £50 for a permit which is valid for one year; and
- (b) from £3·25 to £4·20 for each month, or part thereof for a permit which is valid for less than one year.
