ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

One-Way Traffic (Strabane) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985

Made 5th February 1985

Coming into operation 18th March 1985

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Strabane) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985 and shall come into operation on 18th March 1985.

Revocation

2. The Street Traffic Order made by Strabane Urban District Council on 4th May 1959 relating to provision for one-way traffic on Ballycolman Avenue and Eden Terrace, Strabane is hereby revoked.

Prohibition

3. A person shall not, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on the roads or the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule in a direction other than that specified in relation to those roads or lengths of road in Column 2.

SCHEDULE

Column 1	Column 2
In the town of Strabane:	
Canal Street from its junction with Abercorn Square to its junction with Dock Street	Northerly from Abercorn Square
Castle Place	Westerly from Market Street
Castle Street	South-westerly from Abercorn Square
Church Street from its junction with Abercorn Square to its junction with Patrick Street	North-easterly from Abercorn Square
Main Street from its junction with Castle Street to its junction with Bridge Street	South-easterly from Castle Street

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order makes provision for (1) the restoration of two-way traffic on Ballycolman Avenue and Eden Terrace, Strabane and (2) the introduction of one-way traffic on the roads specified in the Schedule.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will be erected on the roads in due course.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £400.
