Dogs (Grants to District Councils) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985

The Department of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 49(2) of the Dogs (Northern Ireland) Order 1983(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dogs (Grants to District Councils) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985 and shall come into operation on 14th March 1985.

Amendment of the Dogs (Grants to District Councils) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1984

- 2. The Dogs (Grants to District Councils) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1984(b) shall be amended as follows:
 - (a) in regulation 3 for "31st December 1984" there shall be substituted "30th April 1985";
 - (b) in regulation 8 for "31st January 1985" there shall be substituted "28th June 1985".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations extend from 31st December 1984 to 30th April 1985 the date by which initial expenditure has to be incurred by a district council in the establishment of a dog pound if grant is to be payable in respect of such expenditure. The regulations also extend from 31st January 1985 to 28th June 1985 the date by which district councils are required to furnish to the Department of Agriculture documents in support of a claim for payment of grant.
