**The Social Security (Contributions) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1985***Made* 22nd November 1985*Coming into operation* 6th April 1986

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 3 of the Social Security Pensions (Northern Ireland) Order 1975(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Contributions) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985 and shall come into operation on 6th April 1986.

(2) In these regulations “the principal regulations” means the Social Security (Contributions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979(b).

Amendment of regulation 7 of the principal regulations

2. In regulation 7 of the principal regulations (lower and upper earnings limits for Class 1 contributions)—

- (a) for “6th April 1985” there shall be substituted “6th April 1986”; and
- (b) for “£35·50” and “£265” there shall be substituted respectively “£38” and “£285”.
