**The Judgment Enforcement Fees (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1985***Made* 2nd April 1985*Coming into operation* 1st May 1985

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 116(1) and (4) of the Judicature (Northern Ireland) Act 1978(a), after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Judgment Enforcement Fees (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1985.

2. The Schedule to the Judgment Enforcement Fees Order (Northern Ireland) 1982(b) shall be amended by inserting, below the entry relating to Fee No. 10, the new fees set out in the Schedule to this Order.
