The Secretary of State, in pursuance of Article 17(1) and (3)(a) of the Health and Safety at Work (Northern Ireland) Order 1978(a) as applied and modified by Article 53 of that Order and after consulting, in accordance with Article 46 of that Order as so applied and modified, the Health and Safety Agency for Northern Ireland and such other bodies as appear to him to be appropriate, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Explosives (Licensing of Stores and Registration of Premises) Variation of Fees Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985 and shall come into operation on 10th June 1985.

(2) In these regulations—

"the Act of 1875" means the Explosives Act 1875(b).

Modification of the Act

2.—(1) In section 15 of the Act of 1875 (which provides the maximum fee payable for a store licence) for the sum of $\pounds 2.25$ there shall be substituted the sum of $\pounds 28.00$.

(2) In section 18 of the Act of 1875 (which provides the maximum fee payable on renewal of a store licence) for the sum of 63p there shall be substituted the sum of ± 28.00 .

(3) In section 21 of the Act of 1875 (which provides the maximum fee payable for the registration and renewal of the registration of premises used for the keeping of explosives) for the sum of 63p there shall be substituted the sum of £5.00 in each place where it occurs.

Health and Safety EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations modify sections 15, 18 and 21 of the Explosives Act 1875 by increasing the maximum fees payable for a store licence and the renewal of a store licence and the maximum fees payable on the registration and renewal of registration of premises used for the keeping of explosives.
