The Betting, Gaming, Lotteries and Amusements (1985 Order) (Commencement No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1(2) of the Betting, Gaming, Lotteries and Amusements (Northern Ireland) Order 1985(a), paragraph 2(1) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:

Citation and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Betting, Gaming, Lotteries and Amusements (1985 Order) (Commencement No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986.
- (2) In this order "the Order" means the Betting, Gaming, Lotteries and Amusements (Northern Ireland) Order 1985.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This order brings into operation those provisions of the Betting, Gaming, Lotteries and Amusements (Northern Ireland) Order 1985 ("the Order") which relate to gaming, other than on bingo club premises.

It introduces the provision in Article 187(1) whereby magistrates' courts rules may amend the procedures for licences, certificates etc. set out in the relevant Schedules to the Order.

It also brings into operation those provisions of Schedule 19 which provide for consequential amendments of the Licensing Act (Northern Ireland) 1971 and the Rent (Northern Ireland) Order 1978, those provisions of Schedule 20 which provide transitional arrangements for registration of existing clubs not registered under the Registration of Clubs Act (Northern Ireland) 1967 which wish to have gaming machines and those provisions of Schedule 21 which provide for the repeal of existing law on gaming which is either rendered obsolete or is being replaced by provisions of the Order.
