The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 110(1) of the Betting, Gaming, Lotteries and Amusements (Northern Ireland) Order 1985(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Amusement Permit (Prescribed Premises) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1986.

Prescribed premises

- 2. The premises in which gaming by means of a gaming machine in accordance with the conditions of Article 108 of the Betting, Gaming, Lotteries and Amusements (Northern Ireland) Order 1985 is authorised by an amusement permit shall be—
 - (a) premises used wholly or mainly for the provision of amusements by means of gaming machines; or
 - (b) premises used wholly or mainly for the purposes of a pleasure fair consisting wholly or mainly of amusements.

Betting, Gaming and Lotteries EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations prescribe the premises in respect of which a person may be granted an amusement permit by a district council.

Article 110(1) of the Betting, Gaming, Lotteries and Amusements (Northern Ireland) Order 1985 is the enabling provision under which these regulations are made. It is brought into operation on 1st June 1986 by the Betting, Gaming, Lotteries and Amusements (1985 Order) (Commencement No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986. (S.R. 1986 No. 124 (C. 3)).
