The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 114(1) of the Betting, Gaming, Lotteries and Amusements (Northern Ireland) Order 1985(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Gaming Machine (Form of Amusement Permit) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1986.

Form of amusement permit

- 2.—(1) An amusement permit shall be granted in Form 1 and renewed in Form 2 in the Schedule.
- (2) There shall be entered on each permit such of the entries as are therein set out as relate to the grant or renewal of the permit by the district council.
