The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 116(1) of the Judicature (Northern Ireland) Act 1978(a), after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice, and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Magistrates' Courts (Gaming Machine) Fees Order (Northern Ireland) 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1986.

Fees to be taken in magistrates' courts

- 2.—(1) The fees set out in the Schedule to this Order shall be taken in magistrates' courts in respect of items set out opposite thereto.
- (2) The fees prescribed in this Order on any application shall be payable by the party at whose instance the application is made and before it is made.
- (3) The provisions of Article 5 of the Magistrates' Courts Fees Order (Northern Ireland) 1983(b) shall apply with the necessary modifications to the fees prescribed by this Order.
