Local Government (General Grant) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986

Made 23rd July 1986

Coming into operation 4th September 1986

*To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1
to the Northern Ireland Act 1974*

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 3(1) of Part I of Schedule 1 to the Local Government &c. (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(a) and now vested in it(b) and of every power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Government (General Grant) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986 and shall come into operation on 4th September 1986.

General grant

2. For the purposes of paragraph 3(1) of Part I of Schedule 1 to the Local Government &c. (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 the districts specified for the year ending on 31st March 1987 shall be the districts listed below:—
