Teachers' Salaries and Allowances (Payment) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986

Made 1st August 1986
Coming into operation 29th August 1986

The Department of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 69(3) and 134(1) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Teachers' Salaries and Allowances (Payment) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986 and shall come into operation on 29th August 1986.

Amendment of Payment of Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974

2. The Payment of Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974(b) shall be amended as follows:—

(1) After the definition of "board" in regulation 3 there shall be inserted:

“ “Department” means the Department of Education for Northern Ireland.”

(2) For regulation 4 there shall be substituted—

“4.—(1) Except where the managers and the Department agree as provided in sub-paragraph (2), the salaries and allowances of full-time teachers, temporary teachers and part-time teachers in voluntary grammar schools shall be paid by the managers and Article 69(3) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1986 shall apply accordingly.

(2) The Department and the managers may agree that sub-paragraph (1) as it applies in relation to full-time teachers shall not apply to that school.”
