## Industrial and Provident Societies (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986

The Department of Economic Development, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 97(1) of the Industrial and Provident Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1969(a) and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

## Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Industrial and Provident Societies (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986 and shall come into operation on 31st December 1986.

#### Revocation

2. The Industrial and Provident Societies (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985(c) are hereby revoked.

# Amendment of fees

3. For Schedule 2(d) to the Industrial and Provident Societies Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1969(e) there shall be substituted the following Schedule:

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations increase by approximately 5% the fees to be paid for certain matters transacted or arising under the Industrial and Provident Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1969. However the fees for registration of a society and for registration of a complete amendment of rules are unchanged where model rules are used and are increased by approximately 15% where model rules are not used. The fee payable for recording a charge on a society's assets has been increased from £10 to £15. The fee payable for the registration of an instrument of dissolution or of a special resolution relating to an amalgamation or a transfer was formerly determined in accordance with the number of members in a society and is now a single fee. Also the fees for the furnishing of copies of documents in the custody of the registrar and for certification of such documents are now prescribed on the basis of the number of photocopied pages rather than the number of words copied.

The regulations supersede the Industrial and Provident Societies (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985.
