The Supplementary Benefit (Claims and Payments) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986

Made..<

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 19(1) and (2)(i) of the Supplementary Benefits (Northern Ireland) Order 1977(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Supplementary Benefit (Claims and Payments) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986 and shall come into operation on 26th January 1987.

Amendment of the Supplementary Benefit (Claims and Payments) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981

2.—(1) The Supplementary Benefit (Claims and Payments) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981(b) shall be amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) In regulation 14(1) (interpretation of Part IV relating to payments to third parties) for the definition of "mortgage payment" there shall be substituted the following definition—

- (3) In regulation 16 (regular payments to third parties for housing items)-
- (a) in paragraph (2)(b), for the words from "the actual weekly cost" to the end of that sub-paragraph there shall be substituted the following—
 - " (i) in respect of mortgage payments, the weekly amount of the mortgage payment in that case, and
 - (ii) for any other housing item, the actual weekly cost necessary in respect of continuing needs for the relevant item,".
- (b) in paragraph (5)(a), for "2" there shall be substituted "8 weeks".

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Supplementary Benefit (Claims and Payments) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981 ("the principal regulations"). They correspond to provision contained in regulations made by the Secretary of State for Social Services in relation to Great Britain and accordingly, by virtue of section 10(2) of, and paragraph 21 of Schedule 3 to, the Social Security Act 1980 (c. 30) are not subject to the requirement of section 10(1) of that Act for prior reference to the Social Security Advisory Committee.

The regulations substitute a new definition of "mortgage payment" in regulation 14 of the principal regulations so that it now means a payment of the amount of interest applicable to the claimant under regulation 16 or 18 of the Supplementary Benefit (Requirements) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983.

They also amend regulation 16 of the principal regulations by making specific provision in relation to debts in respect of mortgage payments.
