**Perambulators and Pushchairs (Safety) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1986***Made* 6th February 1986*Coming into operation* 1st June 1986*To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1
to the Northern Ireland Act 1974*

The Department of Economic Development, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Consumer Protection Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(a) and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with such persons and bodies of persons as appear to it to be requisite, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Perambulators and Pushchairs (Safety) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1986.

The Perambulators and Pushchairs (Safety) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978

2. The Perambulators and Pushchairs (Safety) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978(c) shall cease to have effect in so far as they relate to pushchairs.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations provide that the Perambulators and Pushchairs (Safety) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978 which impose certain requirements relating to the safety of perambulators and pushchairs cease to apply to pushchairs with effect from 1st June 1986. As from that date the safety of pushchairs will be covered by the Pushchairs (Safety) Regulations 1985 made under the Consumer Safety Act 1978 and which apply to the whole of the United Kingdom.
