Diseases of Animals (Modification) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986

Made 27th March 1986

Coming into operation 12th May 1986

The Department of Agriculture, being satisfied that the modification of Schedule 2 to the Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) set out in Article 3 is necessary or expedient for the purposes of that Order, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 16(2) of that Order and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Diseases of Animals (Modification) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986 and shall come into operation on 12th May 1986.

Modification of the Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981

2. Schedule 2 to the Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 is hereby modified as follows:—

(1) in paragraph 10 of Part I of Schedule 2 there shall be added to the list of diseases—

“Infectious Bovine Rhinotracheitis”

(2) in paragraph 12 of Part II of Schedule 2 there shall be added to the list of diseases—

“Infectious Bovine Rhinotracheitis”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order modifies Schedule 2 to the Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 by—

- (a) adding Infectious Bovine Rhinotracheitis to the list of diseases in paragraph 10 of Part I of the Schedule. This allows the Department to slaughter any cattle affected or suspected of being affected with Infectious Bovine Rhinotracheitis or any cattle having come in contact with any cattle so affected or suspected of being so affected; and
- (b) adding Infectious Bovine Rhinotracheitis to the list of diseases in paragraph 12 of Part II of the Schedule. This provides for the compensation payable for any cattle so slaughtered.
