This Order brings into operation on 15th August 1987 the Education (Corporal Punishment) (Northern Ireland) Order 1987 which removes the right of members of the staff of schools in Northern Ireland to administer corporal punishment to pupils whose education is provided at grant-aided schools or is otherwise secured by education and library boards.
