One-Way Traffic (Belfast) (Amendment No. 2) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1987

Made . . . . . 29th July 1987  
Coming into operation . . . . . 13th September 1987

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf makes the following Order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Belfast) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1987 and shall come into operation on 13th September 1987.

*Amendment*

2. The One-Way Traffic (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986(b) shall be amended by the deletion from Schedule 2 of the item relating to Dundela Street.
