ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Urban Clearways (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1987

Made 18th September 1987

Coming into operation 1st November 1987

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Urban Clearways (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1987 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1987.

Amendment

2. In column 2 of the Schedule to the Urban Clearways (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981(b) for the words “4.30 p.m. to 6.30 p.m.” wherever they occur substitute the words “4.30 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This order amends the Urban Clearways (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981 by reducing the time specified in column 2 of the Schedule, during which waiting is prohibited from "4.30 p.m. to 6.30 p.m." to "4.30 p.m. to 6.00 p.m."

Any person who acts in contravention of the order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£400).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the order will be erected on the roads.
