Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Weight Restriction (Whitehead) (Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1987 and shall come into operation on 22nd November 1987.

2. The Traffic Weight Restriction (Whitehead) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985(b) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order revokes the Traffic Weight Restriction (Whitehead) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985 which prohibited vehicles exceeding 3 tonnes laden or unladen weight from using the length of King's Road, Whitehead, carried by the railway bridge.
