BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES**Gaming (Bingo) (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1987**

Made 23rd October 1987

Coming into operation 7th December 1987

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 76(2) of the Betting, Gaming, Lotteries and Amusements (Northern Ireland) Order 1985(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Gaming (Bingo) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 and shall come into operation on 7th December 1987.

Amendment of regulation

2. In regulation 2(1)(b) and (c) of the Gaming (Bingo) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987(b) for “£4” there shall be substituted “£4.60”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Gaming (Bingo) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 by increasing the maximum charge which may be made in respect of gaming by way of bingo on bingo club premises from £4 to £4·60.
