## HOUSING; RATES

**The Housing Benefits (Amendment No. 2) Regulations  
(Northern Ireland) 1987**

*Made* . . . . . 6th March 1987

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 30th March 1987

Whereas the Secretary of State for Social Services has made regulations under section 28(1) of the Social Security and Housing Benefits Act 1982(a) and by virtue of Article 4 of the Housing Benefits (Northern Ireland) Order 1983(b) corresponding regulations may be made for Northern Ireland:—

Now, therefore, the Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 3(2) of that Order and acting jointly with the Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Article 3(1) of that Order, in each case with the consent of the Department of Finance and Personnel, and in exercise of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations:

*Citation and commencement*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Housing Benefits (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 and shall come into operation on 30th March 1987.

*Amendment of the Housing Benefits Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985*

2. In Schedule 2 to the Housing Benefits Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985(c) (amounts to be disregarded when ascertaining weekly income for any housing benefit), in paragraph 20(ab) for “£23·85” there shall be substituted “£24·35”.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These regulations further amend the Housing Benefits Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985 by increasing the amount to be disregarded in respect of parental contributions to certain students when ascertaining weekly income for any housing benefit.

They correspond to provision contained in regulations made by the Secretary of State for Social Services in relation to Great Britain and accordingly, by virtue of section 10(2) of, and paragraph 21 of Schedule 3 to, the Social Security Act 1980 (c. 30) are not subject to the requirement of section 10(1) of that Act for prior reference to the Social Security Advisory Committee.
