Grassland Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1988

<i>Made</i>	<i>11th April 1988</i>
<i>Coming into operation</i>	<i>12th April 1988</i>

The Department of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 6(1) of the Agriculture Act (Northern Ireland) 1949(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Department of Finance and Personnel(b), hereby makes the following Scheme.

Citation and commencement

1. This Scheme may be cited as the Grassland Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 12th April 1988.

Interpretation

2. In this Scheme—

“agricultural business” means a business consisting in or such part of any business as consists in the pursuit of agriculture including the storage, the transport and the preparation for market of the produce of the business”;

“the Department” means the Department of Agriculture;

“development plan” means a development plan approved under the Agriculture and Horticulture Development Regulations 1980(c), the Farm and Horticulture Development Regulations 1981(d), the Agriculture and Horticulture Development Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987(e), or the Farm and Horticulture Development Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987(f);

“earned income” in relation to an agricultural business means the revenue of the business including net inventory changes and farm house consumption but excluding remuneration from capital invested in the agricultural business and farm production costs (excluding costs of labour);

“improvement plan” means an improvement plan approved under the Agriculture Improvement Regulations 1985(a), or the Agriculture Improvement Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987(b);

“labour unit” means the amount of work, other than work done by contractors, which would occupy the full-time not exceeding 2,300 hours per year of a full-time worker;

“less favoured area” means land which is situated in an area included in the list of less favoured farming areas adopted by the Council or the Commission of the European Communities under Article 2 of Council Directive No. 75/268/EEC(c) on mountain and hill farming and farming in certain less favoured areas;

Application of scheme

3. Claims may be made under this Scheme which relate to any area of Northern Ireland except insofar as it has been designated a less favoured area.

Payment of grant

4. Subject to the provisions of this Scheme the Department may make a grant to any person towards expenditure incurred by him for the purposes of, or in connection with, the carrying on of an agricultural business, being expenditure which appears to the Department to be of a capital nature or incurred in connection with expenditure of a capital nature.

Restrictions on the payment of grant

5. The Department shall not pay grant under this Scheme in relation to any expenditure if—

- (a) at the time of receipt of the claim for grant the agricultural business in relation to which the expenditure has been incurred is the subject of a current development plan or of a current improvement plan; or
- (b) the agricultural business in respect of which the grant is claimed has an earned income per labour unit in excess of the reference income specified in Article 8 in respect of the calendar year in which the grant is claimed.

Amount of grant

6. Subject to the provisions of this Scheme, the Department may pay the rate of grant specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 on expenditure incurred on the item specified in column 1 of that Schedule.

Standard costs

7. The cost of any work or facility for the purpose of determining the amount of any grant payable shall, if the claimant so elects, be such standard costs or amount as are specified in forms SC1 (published October 1985) and SC2 (published October 1985) by the Department.

Reference income

8. For the purposes of this Scheme the reference income shall be £9,200.

Notification of area and limits

9.—(1) Before incurring expenditure upon which it is intended to claim grant a person shall notify the Department in writing of the area of land in respect of which grant is to be claimed.

(2) The minimum area of land in respect of which the Department may pay grant under this Scheme shall, in the case of any agricultural business, be 1 hectare.

(3) The maximum area of land in respect of which the Department may pay grant under this Scheme shall, in the case of any agricultural business, be 15 hectares.

Claims for grant

10. Any claims for a grant under this Scheme shall be in the form specified in Schedule 2.

Closing date for commencement of work and making of claims

11. The Department shall pay grant under this Scheme in respect of claims for the item listed in column 1 of Schedule 1 only if the work in respect of that item commenced on or before 30th September 1988 and the claim is received by the Department on or before 31st December 1988.

Recovery of grant

12. If the Department has paid a grant under this Scheme and finds that the whole or part of such payment ought not to have been made it shall be entitled to recover on demand as a civil debt from the person to whom such payment was made so much of the said sum as ought not to have been paid.

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Scheme.)

This Scheme provides for the payment of grants in Northern Ireland towards expenditure incurred in the reseeded and regeneration of grassland (excluding heathland and moorland) outside the Less Favoured Areas. These grants are not payable where the agricultural business to which the claim for grant relates is the subject of a current development plan approved under the Agriculture and Horticulture Development Regulations 1980, the Farm and Horticulture Development Regulations 1981, the Agriculture and Horticulture Development Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 or the Farm and Horticulture Development Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 or a current improvement plan approved under the Agriculture Improvement Regulations 1985 or the Agriculture Improvement Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 (Articles 2 and 5).

The Scheme—

- (a) restricts the payment of grant by reference to the revenue of an agricultural business measured against the volume of work in the business (Articles 2, 5 and 8);
- (b) specifies the rate of grant (Article 6 and Schedule 1);
- (c) imposes requirements as to the notification of the area of land in respect of which grant is to be claimed and provides that payment of grant will be restricted to a minimum of one hectare and a maximum of 15 hectares for each agricultural business (Article 9);
- (d) specifies a form for claiming grant (Article 10 and Schedule 2);
- (e) specifies closing dates for commencement of work and making of claims (Article 11);
- (f) makes provision for the recovery of grant (Article 12).

The forms, mentioned in Article 7 which specify standard costs, the claim forms, mentioned in Article 10 and explanatory leaflets (GS 2/88) are available on application to local Advisory Offices of the Department of Agriculture. Copies of Council Directive No. 75/268/EEC are available for inspection at the Department's County Agricultural Executive Offices.
