**Students Awards (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1988**

Made 7th June 1988

Coming into operation 15th July 1988

The Department of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 50(1) and (2), 51(2) and 134(1) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Students Awards (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on 15th July 1988 and shall have effect on and from 11th April 1988.

Amendment of Students Awards Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987

2.—(1) The Students Awards Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987(b) shall be amended in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (2).

(2) In Part I of Schedule 8 there shall be added—

(a) at the end of paragraph 1(1)(j) the words “any income support under the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(c) or any transitional addition, personal expenses addition or special transitional addition payable under Part III of the Income Support (Transitional) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987(d);”; and

(b) at the end of paragraph 1(1)(l) the words “or any housing benefit under the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Order 1986 or Part II of the Social Security Act 1986(e);”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations, which have effect retrospectively on and from 11th April 1988, amend paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 8 to the Students Awards Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 by adding income support payable under the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Order 1986, housing benefit payable under the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Order 1986 or Part II of the Social Security Act 1986 and payments under Part III of the Income Support (Transitional) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 to those of the student's resources that may be disregarded for the purpose of calculating his income. Retrospection is authorised by Articles 50(2) and 51(2) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1986, S.I. 1986/594 (N.I. 3).
