The Magistrates' Courts Fees (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 116(1) of the Judicature (Northern Ireland) Act 1978(a), after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice, and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Magistrates' Courts Fees (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1988.
- 2. For Schedule 2 to the Magistrates' Courts Fees Order (Northern Ireland) 1983(b) there shall be substituted the Schedule 2 set out in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE 2	Article 6
Fees Payable for Service of a Summons or Process	
1.—(1) Subject to sub-paragraph (2) and paragraph 3, for the service of a summons or process or document	£4·00
(2) Where service of a summons or process is required to be personal	£6·00
2. For the service of a summons or process where there are two or more defendants or witnesses in the same proceedings there shall be a separate fee for each defendant or witness.	
3. Where a document relating to a summons is served together with the summons, for each document served	£2·50
