**LIVESTOCK MARKETING COMMISSION FOR
NORTHERN IRELAND****Livestock Marketing Commission (Levy) (Amendment)
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988**

Made 23rd September 1988

Coming into operation 24th October 1988

The Department of Agriculture, on the recommendation of the Livestock Marketing Commission for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 4(1) and (3) of the Livestock Marketing Commission Act (Northern Ireland) 1967(a) and regulation 3 of the Livestock Marketing Commission (Maximum Levy) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Livestock Marketing Commission (Levy) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 24th October 1988.

Amendment

2. The Livestock Marketing Commission (Levy) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1969(c) shall be amended as follows:—

- (a) in regulation 2 for paragraphs (1) and (2) there shall be substituted—
“(1) where the animal is bovine, 80 pence; and
(2) where the animal is a sheep, 8 pence.”; and
(b) for the Schedule there shall be substituted the Schedule.

Revocation

3. The Livestock Marketing Commission (Levy) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976(d) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Livestock Marketing Commission (Levy) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1969 which imposes a levy to be collected by or on behalf of the Livestock Marketing Commission ("the Commission") in respect of sheep and bovine animals slaughtered in or sent out of Northern Ireland.

The regulations increase the levies payable—

- (a) in the case of bovine animals shipped live to Great Britain, from 25 pence to 80 pence;
- (b) in the case of all other bovine animals from 45 pence to 80 pence; and
- (c) in the case of sheep, from 4 pence to 8 pence.

The form of return which the owner of premises on which the sheep or cattle are slaughtered is required to make to the Commission is also revised.

The regulations also revoke the Livestock Marketing Commission (Levy) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976.
