CHILDREN AND YOUNG PERSONS**Attendance Centre (Amendment) Rules
(Northern Ireland) 1988**

Made 23rd November 1988

Coming into operation 1st February 1989

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 134(2) of the Children and Young Persons Act (Northern Ireland) 1968(a) hereby makes the following rules:—

Citation and commencement

1. These rules may be cited as the Attendance Centre (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 1st February 1989.

Interpretation

2. In these rules “the principal rules” means the Attendance Centre Rules (Northern Ireland) 1970(b).

General

3. In rule 3 of the principal rules the words “for the reception of male persons” shall be omitted.

Occupation and instruction

4. At the end of rule 4 of the principal rules there shall be added the following paragraph:—

“(3) A female member of the staff shall, at all times, be in attendance at a centre provided for the reception of female persons and female persons attending at a centre shall, whilst participating in physical training, so far as practicable, be supervised by a female member of the staff.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Rules.)

These rules amend the Attendance Centre Rules (Northern Ireland) 1970 so as to make provision for the attendance at attendance centres of female persons.

Rule 4 provides for female persons attending attendance centres to be supervised by a female member of the staff when participating in physical training and for a female member of the staff to be in attendance at all times at a centre provided for the reception of female persons.
