HEALTH AND PERSONAL SOCIAL SERVICES**General Dental Services (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1988***Made* 24th February 1988*Coming into operation* 28th March 1988

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 61, 106 and 107 of the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with such organisations as appear to the Department to be representative of the dental profession as required by Article 61(4) of the said Order, and in conjunction with the Department of Finance and Personnel(b), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the General Dental Services (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 28th March 1988.

Amendment

2. The Health and Personal Social Services (General Dental Services) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975(c) shall be amended as follows:—

In regulation 18(1) (Statement of dental remuneration)—

- (a) in column 1 (Determination) below “V” there shall be added “VA”;
- and
- (b) in column 2 (Subject matter of determination), there shall be added, so as to relate to determination VA, “Allowances in respect of a dentist undergoing a period of training;”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Health and Personal Social Services (General Dental Services) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975.

They amend the Regulations by providing for the Statement of Dental Remuneration (distributed to those providing general dental services), to include allowances in respect of dentists undergoing training.
