ELECTRICITY SUPPLY**Electricity (Permitted Supply) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988**

Made 24th March 1988
Coming into operation 22nd April 1988

Whereas the Department of Economic Development (hereinafter called “the Department”) is satisfied that the persons referred to in the Schedule desire to obtain a supply of electricity from the Electricity Supply Board of the Republic of Ireland and whereas Northern Ireland Electricity(a) has given its consent to that supply:

Now, therefore, the Department in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 31 of the Electricity Supply (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and now vested in it(c), hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Electricity (Permitted Supply) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 22nd April 1988.

Permission of Department

2. The Department hereby grants permission to the persons referred to in the Schedule to obtain from the Electricity Supply Board of the Republic of Ireland a supply of electricity for their premises at their respective addresses.
