HORSE RACING AND BETTING

Horse Racing and Betting (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989

Made 19th May 1989 1st July 1989 Coming into operation

To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974

The Department of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 11(2) of the Horse Racing and Betting (Northern Ireland) Order 1976(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, after consultation with such organisations as appear to the Department to substantially represent the interests of bookmakers, and with the approval of the Department of Finance and Personnel(b), hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Horse Racing and Betting (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1989.

Charges on bookmakers

- 2. In Article 11(1) of the Horse Racing and Betting (Northern Ireland) Order 1976 (charges to be paid by bookmakers to the Department prior to applications for or in respect of certain licences)—
 - (a) in sub-paragraph (a) (bookmaker's licence) for "£17"(c) there shall be substituted "£18"; and
 - (b) in sub-paragraph (b) (bookmaking office licence) for "£240"(c) there shall be substituted "£255".

Revocation

3. The Horse Racing and Betting (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988(d) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

Article 11(1) of the Horse Racing and Betting (Northern Ireland) Order 1976 specifies charges to be paid to the Department of Agriculture ("the Department") by bookmakers who intend to make applications for or in respect of certain licences. This money is paid by the Department into the Horse Racing Fund which is used for assisting the maintenance and development of Down Royal Racecourse.

This Order amends that Article by increasing the charges payable—

- (a) by bookmakers, other than those mentioned in (b) below, who intend to apply for the grant or renewal of a bookmaker's licence from £17 to £18: and
- (b) by bookmakers who intend to apply for the grant or renewal of a bookmaking office licence or to have the provisional grant of a bookmaking office licence declared final from £240 to £255.
