The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred by section  $\hat{1}(1)$  of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 1 to, the Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland)  $1968(\hat{a})$  and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Petroleum-Spirit Licences (Fees) (Increase) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989 and shall come into operation on 4th September 1989.

#### Increase of fee for grant of petroleum-spirit licence

2. For the fees set out in Schedule 1 to the Petroleum (Consolidation) Act (Northern Ireland) 1929(c), as specified in column 2 of the Schedule, there shall be substituted the fees set out in column 3 of the Schedule.
