**(Northern Ireland) 1989***Made* . . . . . 26th July 1989*Coming into operation* . . . . . 15th September 1989*To be laid before Parliament*

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Article 4(3) of the Domestic Proceedings (Northern Ireland) Order 1980(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Domestic Proceedings (Lump Sums) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989 and shall come into operation on 15th September 1989.

*Increase in limit of lump sums*

2. For the purposes of Article 4(3) of the Domestic Proceedings (Northern Ireland) Order 1980 (lump sums for financial provision) the maximum amount of any lump sum required to be paid by an order to which that provision applies is hereby fixed at £1,000.
