## SOCIAL SECURITY

**The Income Support (General) (Amendment No. 2)  
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1989**

*Made* . . . . . 4th August 1989

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 21st August 1989

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(12)(d) of the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

*Citation, commencement and interpretation*

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Income Support (General) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1989 and shall come into operation on 21st August 1989.

(2) In these regulations “the principal regulations” means the Income Support (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987(b).

*Amendment of regulation 2 of the principal regulations*

2. In regulation 2(1) of the principal regulations (interpretation) in the definition of “training allowance” after “full-time education” there shall be inserted “, other than under arrangements made under section 1(1) of the Employment and Training Act (Northern Ireland) 1950(c),”.

*Amendment of regulation 10 of the principal regulations*

3. In regulation 10(1)(h) of the principal regulations (circumstances in which claimants are not to be treated as available for employment) for “paragraph 1, 2, 7 or 20” there shall be substituted “paragraph 1, 2, 7, 11 or 20”.

These regulations further amend the Income Support (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987. They make provision for certain persons who are undergoing employment training to qualify for income support.

The regulations correspond to provision contained in regulations made by the Secretary of State for Social Security in relation to Great Britain and accordingly, by virtue of section 10(2) of, and paragraph 21 of Schedule 3 to, the Social Security Act 1980 (c. 30), are not subject to the requirement of section 10(1) of that Act for prior reference to the Social Security Advisory Committee.
