Family Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) (1984 Order Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989

The Department of Finance and Personnel, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1(3) of the Family Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1984(a) and paragraph 2(1) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Family Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) (1984 Order Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1989.

Appointed day — Part II of the 1984 Order (matrimonial homes)

- 2. The following provisions of the Family Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1984 shall come into operation on 1st September 1989—
 - (a) Part II (matrimonial homes), except Article 11 and Schedule 1 (transfer of certain tenancies on divorce, etc.);
 - (b) Article 21(1) in so far as it gives effect to Part I of Schedule 2 (amendments consequential on Part II of the 1984 Order).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings Part II of the Family Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1984 (matrimonial homes) into operation on 1st September 1989. Apart from Article 11 and Schedule 1, the 1984 Order will be fully in operation from that date: the other provisions came into operation on 20th February 1985 in accordance with Article 1(2) of the 1984 Order.

Article 11 and Schedule 1 (transfer of certain tenancies on divorce, etc.) have been superseded by new provisions in the Matrimonial and Family Proceedings (Northern Ireland) Order 1989 and are repealed with effect from a day to be appointed by that Order.
