(Northern Ireland) Regulations 1989**

Made 3rd March 1989

Coming into operation 1st May 1989

To be laid before Parliament

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Article 13(5) of the Criminal Injuries (Compensation) (Northern Ireland) Order 1988(a), I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Criminal Injuries (Compensation) (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1989 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1989.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations “the Order” means the Criminal Injuries (Compensation) (Northern Ireland) Order 1988.

Condition of payment of compensation

3. The discharge required to be signed by the applicant, under the terms of Article 13(5) of the Order, shall be in the form set out in the Schedule.

CRIMINAL INJURIES (COMPENSATION) (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1988

Discharge under Article 13(5)

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations prescribe the form of discharge to be signed by an applicant for compensation under Article 4 of the Criminal Injuries (Compensation) (Northern Ireland) Order 1988 to confirm acceptance of the amount of compensation which has been determined by the Secretary of State in full satisfaction of the claim for compensation. On signing the discharge the determination becomes in all respects final and binding.
