PUBLIC HEALTH**Public Health Notifiable Diseases Order
(Northern Ireland) 1989**

Made 14th March 1989

Coming into operation 24th April 1989

The Department of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1(2) of the Public Health Act (Northern Ireland) 1967(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Health Notifiable Diseases Order (Northern Ireland) 1989 and shall come into operation on 24th April 1989.

Replacement of Schedule

2. For Schedule 1 to the Public Health Act (Northern Ireland) 1967 there shall be substituted the Schedule contained in the Schedule to this Order.

Revocation

3. The Public Health Notifiable Diseases Order (Northern Ireland) 1988(b) is hereby revoked.
