## WELFARE FOODS

**The Welfare Foods (Amendment No. 2) Regulations  
(Northern Ireland) 1990**

*Made* . . . . . 29th March 1990

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 1st April 1990

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 13(4) of the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Order 1988(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

*Citation, commencement and interpretation*

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Welfare Foods (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1990:

(2) In these regulations “the principal regulations” means the Welfare Foods Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988(b).

*Amendment of the principal regulations*

2. In regulation 1(2) of the principal regulations (interpretation) in the definition of “approved price” for “29p” there shall be substituted “30p”.

*Revocation*

3. The Welfare Foods (Amendment No. 3) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1989(c) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These regulations further amend the Welfare Foods Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988 by increasing from 29p to 30p the approved price for a pint of pasteurised milk supplied under those regulations or, if a supplier supplies milk only in metric measures, for a half litre of such milk. The regulations also contain a revocation.
