The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 199(4) and 218(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Regulations:

#### Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Fixed Penalty) (Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990 and shall come into operation on 4th June 1990.

#### Regulations amended

2. The Road Traffic (Fixed Penalty) (Procedure) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966(b) shall be amended as follows:

(1) For regulation 1A (interpretation) substitute—

*<i>''Interpretation* 

1A. In these Regulations a reference to "the Clerk of Petty Sessions" shall, where appropriate, include a reference to the Payments Officer at the Fixed Penalty Notice Payments Office, Belfast.".

(2) For regulation 2 (form of notice) substitute-

"2. A notice under Article 199(4) or 200(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 offering the opportunity, by payment of a fixed penalty, of the discharge of any liability to conviction of an offence to which Articles 199 to 204 (other than Article 201) of that Order apply, shall be in the form set out in the Schedule.".

(3) For the Schedule substitute----

# Criminal Procedure EXPLANATORY NOTE

#### (This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Road Traffic (Fixed Penalty) (Procedure) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966 by providing for a new form of fixed penalty notice.

The notice offers the opportunity to discharge any liability to conviction of the offence specified by payment of a fixed penalty. The Regulations provide that, where appropriate, a reference to the Clerk of Petty Sessions shall include a reference to the Payments Officer at the Fixed Penalty Notice Payments Office, Belfast (regulation 2(1)). The Regulations also prescribe where the fixed penalty is payable and the procedure to be followed for payment.

The Road Traffic (Fixed Penalty) (Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978 and 1986 are revoked as a consequence of these Regulations.
