The Education Reform (1989 Order) (Commencement No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1990

Made 2nd July 1990

The Department of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1(3) and (4) of the Education Reform (Northern Ireland) Order 1989(a) and of every other power enabling it on that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Education Reform (1989 Order) (Commencement No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1990.

Interpretation

2. In this Order "the 1989 Order" means the Education Reform (Northern Ireland) Order 1989.

Commencement

- 3. Article 5(1)(b) and (4) and Article 11(1)(b) of the 1989 Order shall come into operation on 1st August 1990.
- **4.** Article 6(1) and (2) of and Schedule 2 to the 1989 Order in so far as they relate to the compulsory contributory subjects, English, Mathematics and Science shall come into operation—
 - (a) on 1st August 1990 in relation to pupils in the first year of the first, second and third key stages;
 - (b) on 1st August 1991 in relation to pupils in the second year of the first, second and third key stages;
 - (c) on 1st August 1992 in relation to pupils in the third year of the first, second and third key stages;
 - (d) on 1st August 1993 in relation to pupils in the fourth year of the first key stage and the first year of the fourth key stage; and
 - (e) on 1st August 1994 in relation to pupils in the second year of the fourth key stage.

- 5. Article 6(1) and (2) of and Schedule 2 to the 1989 Order in so far as they relate to the compulsory contributory subject, Irish (in Irish speaking schools only) shall come into operation—
 - (a) on 1st August 1990 in relation to pupils in the first year of the first and second key stages;
 - (b) on 1st August 1991 in relation to pupils in the second year of the first and second key stages;
 - (c) on 1st August 1992 in relation to pupils in the third year of the first and second key stages; and
 - (d) on 1st August 1993 in relation to pupils in the fourth year of the first key stage.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into operation certain compulsory contributory subjects provisions of the Education Reform (Northern Ireland) Order 1989 ("the 1989 Order") in so far as these provisions relate to the compulsory contributory subjects of English, Mathematics, Science and Irish (in Irish speaking schools only). The Order brings these provisions into operation in relation to these compulsory contributory subjects on a phased basis so that they first apply in respect of pupils as they begin appropriate key stages. The Order also brings into operation on 1st August 1990 provisions of the 1989 Order—

- (a) relating to attainment targets and programmes of study; and
- (b) dealing with the duties of a Board of Governors and a principal in relation to the teaching of the listed contributory subjects in accordance with a school's curriculum.
