Coming into operation 1st April 1990

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of Article 21(1) of the Criminal Damage (Compensation) (Northern Ireland) Order 1977(a), hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Criminal Damage (Compensation) (Northern Ireland) Order 1977 (Amendment) Order 1990 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1990.

Interpretation

2. In this order “the Order” means the Criminal Damage (Compensation) (Northern Ireland) Order 1977(a).

3. In Article 6 and in paragraphs (6) and (7) of Article 10 of the Order for “£100” there shall be substituted “£200”.
