Further Education Teachers' Salaries (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990

The Department of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 69(1) and (4), 70(1)(b) and 134(1) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(a), and by section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Further Education Teachers' Salaries (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990 and shall come into operation on 31st July 1990 and except where otherwise provided shall have effect on and from 1st April 1989.

Amendment to the Further Education Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988

- 2. The Further Education Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988(c) shall be amended as follows—
 - (a) in regulation 10 (head of department) for the sums "£1,833" and "£1,626" there shall be substituted "£1,989" and "£1,764" respectively;
 - (b) in regulation 18(1) (payment of unqualified teachers) for "£5,472" there shall be substituted "£5,937";
 - (c) in regulation 19(2) (payment of part-time teachers) for the sums "£16·92", "£14·42" and "£10·60", there shall be substituted "£18·35", "£15·65" and "£11·50" respectively and with effect on and from 1st April 1990 "£18·44", "£15·72" and "£11·55" respectively;
 - (d) for regulation 20 (interpretation) with effect on and from 1st September 1990 there shall be substituted—

"Interpretation

- 20. In regulations 21 and 22—
- (a) "teacher" means both a full-time teacher (other than a temporary teacher who is paid on a daily basis in accordance with regulation 17(1)) and a part-time teacher paid in accordance with regulation 19(1);
- (b) "salary" includes any allowance to which a teacher is entitled under regulation 9 or 10;
- (c) "full rate" means the amount of salary that would have been paid had the teacher not been absent owing to illness.";
- (e) in regulation 21 (absence due to illness) with effect on and from 1st September 1990 the words "full-time" shall be omitted wherever they appear;
- (f) in regulation 25 (teachers in service on 30th June 1988) for "30th June 1988" there shall be substituted "31st March 1989";
- (g) for Schedule 1 (salary scales and salary ranges) there shall be substituted the Schedule to these Regulations.

Transitional provisions

- 3. Regulation 2(g) shall not affect—
- (a) the transfer to the senior lecturer scale of a teacher who was on points 12, 13 or 14 of the lecturer scale before the coming into operation of these Regulations or the incremental progression of such a teacher;
- (b) the placing above point 5 on the senior lecturer scale of a teacher who had reached point 5 of that scale before 1st September 1990 or the incremental progression of such a teacher;
- (c) the placing above point 4 on the principal lecturer scale of a teacher who had reached point 4 of that scale before 1st September 1990 or the incremental progression of such a teacher.

1(b) The scales of salaries for principal lecturers shall be as follows:—

Standards of Work

- 2. For the purposes of paragraphs 3, 5 and 6—
- (a) work of category II/III standard means courses above National Certificate or equivalent standard leading directly to a university degree or equivalent qualification or courses with entry standards equivalent to 1 or 2 General Certificate of Education "A" levels and which lead directly to qualifications which satisfy the academic criteria accepted for graduate status for salary purposes or study of an equivalent standard not necessarily leading to the qualifications mentioned; and
- (b) "a significant amount" shall normally be interpreted as at least 50% of the lecturer's work time during the year in question, and shall be calculated as an average per annum over the immediately preceding 3 years, if this is more favourable to the lecturer.

Lecturer

- 3.—(1) A lecturer who is responsible for a significant amount of work of Category II/III standard during the 1989/90 academic year shall on reaching point 12 of the lecturer scale be transferred when he becomes entitled to his next increment, subject to the board having satisfied the Department as to his ability to carry out the duties of senior lecturer, to point 0 of the senior lecturer scale and shall thereafter proceed on the senior lecturer scale by normal incremental progression.
- (2) The arrangements under sub-paragraph (1) shall not prevent the promotion of such a lecturer to senior lecturer.
- 4.—(1) A lecturer who was entitled to an additional £531 per annum under paragraph 4, 5 or 6 of Schedule 1 to the Further Education Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988 as they had effect on 31st March 1989 or would have been so entitled after that date but for the Further Education Teachers' Salaries (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990 shall instead be entitled to an additional £576 per annum.
- (2) With effect on and from 1st April 1990 in sub-paragraph (1) for "£576 per annum" there shall be substituted "£579 per annum".

Senior Lecturer

- 5.—(1) The salary point 0 on the senior lecturer scale shall only apply in respect of a lecturer transferring to the senior lecturer scale under paragraph 3(1) or under a corresponding provision of Regulations regulating the salaries of teachers in Institutions of Further Education before the coming into operation of the Further Education Teachers' Salaries (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990.
- (2) A senior lecturer who during the 1989/90 academic year is responsible for a significant amount of work of Category II/III standard shall on reaching point 5 of the senior lecturer salary scale be entitled to progress to the next point on that scale automatically on his next incremental date.
- (3) On and from 1st September 1990 a senior lecturer other than one to whom sub-paragraph (2) applies shall only receive a salary greater than that related to point 5 of the senior lecturer scale where the board satisfies the Department that he is entitled to do so in the light of the duties and responsibilities being undertaken by him.

Principal Lecturer

6. On and from 1st September 1990 a principal lecturer shall only receive a salary greater than that related to point 4 of the principal lecturer scale where he was responsible for a significant amount of work of Category II/III standard during the academic year 1989/90.

Heads of Department

7. The scales of salaries for Heads of Department shall be as follows:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Further Education Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988 as amended and give effect from 1st April 1989 to an increase of 8.5% in salaries and allowances for teachers in institutions of further education, a further increase of 0.5% with effect from 1st April 1990 for certain teachers and assimilation to a management salary spine from 1st September 1989 for others.

Revised salary scales and salary ranges are set out in the Schedule.

The Regulations revise arrangements for the transfer of lecturers to the senior lecturer scale and progression beyond the bar point for senior lecturers and principal lecturers.

The revised maximum allowances for certain heads of department are set out in regulation 2(a).

The revised rate of salary for unqualified teachers is set out in regulation 2(b).

Revised hourly rates of pay for part-time teachers are set out in regulation 2(c).

Under regulation 2(d) and (e) certain part-time teachers are, with effect on and from 1st September 1990, eligible to be paid for absence owing to illness.

The provision for the protection of the salaries of full-time teachers in post has been updated in regulation 2(f).

These Regulations have retrospective effect by virtue of section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.
