In exercise of the powers conferred by section 18(3) of the Payments for Debt (Emergency Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1971(a) and now vested in me(b) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Payments for Debt (Emergency Provisions) Order (Northern Ireland) 1990 and shall come into operation on 24th July 1990.

2. In this Order “the Act of 1971” means the Payments for Debt (Emergency Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1971.

3. It is hereby declared that 24th July 1990 is the date on which the emergency that was the occasion of the enactment of all the provisions of the Act of 1971 came to an end.
