**Education (Grant-maintained Integrated Schools)  
(Capital Grants) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990**

*Made* . . . . . 10th October 1990

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 12th November 1990

The Department of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 77(8) and (10) of the Education Reform (Northern Ireland) Order 1989(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

*Citation, commencement and interpretation*

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Education (Grant-maintained Integrated Schools) (Capital Grants) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990 and shall come into operation on 12th November 1990.

*Power to pay capital grants*

2. The Department may pay to the trustees or Board of Governors of a grant-maintained integrated school, capital grants in respect of approved expenditure of a capital nature incurred or to be incurred for the purposes of the school.

*Meaning of "expenditure of a capital nature"*

3. For the purpose of Regulation 3 and Article 77 of the Education Reform (Northern Ireland) Order 1989(a), expenditure which is of a class or description specified in the Schedule shall be expenditure of a capital nature.

**Expenditure of a Capital Nature**

1. Expenditure of a capital nature is expenditure on or in connection with,—
- (a) the acquisition, reclamation, improvement or laying out of any land;
  - (b) the acquisition, construction, enlargement, improvement or demolition of any building, wall, fence or other structure, or any playground or other hard-standing;
  - (c) the laying out of playing fields and other facilities for social activities or physical recreation;
  - (d) the provision of furniture, plant, machinery, vehicles, vessels or other apparatus or equipment,
- used or intended to be used for the purposes of the school.

2. In paragraph 1 above “building” includes any fixtures and fittings affixed to a building.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations provide for the payment by the Department of Education to the trustees or Boards of Governors of grant-maintained integrated schools of grants in respect of approved expenditure of a capital nature incurred or to be incurred for the purposes of the school. They prescribe in particular the descriptions of expenditure which is to be regarded as expenditure of a capital nature for the purposes of those grants.
