Company Auditors (Recognition Orders) (Application Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990

The Department of Economic Development, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 47(1) and (3) of the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1990(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Company Auditors (Recognition Orders) (Application Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1990.

Fees

- 2.—(1) An applicant for a recognition order declaring the applicant to be a recognised supervisory body for the purposes of Part III of the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1990 shall pay a fee of £730 in respect of its application.
- (2) An applicant for a recognition order declaring a qualification offered by the applicant to be a recognised professional qualification for the purposes of Part III of the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1990 shall pay a fee of £500 in respect of its application.
