Fisheries (Rainbow Trout Waters) Byelaws
(Northern Ireland) 1990

Made 30th October 1990

Coming into operation 31st October 1990

The Fisheries Conservancy Board for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 26(1) of the Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Department of Agriculture hereby makes the following Byelaws:

Citation and commencement

1. These Byelaws may be cited as the Fisheries (Rainbow Trout Waters) Byelaws (Northern Ireland) 1990 and shall come into operation on 31st October 1990.

Amendment

2. In Schedule 4 to the Fisheries Consolidated and Amendment Byelaws (Northern Ireland) 1989(b) (waters where there is no close season for angling for rainbow trout) after "Magheralagan Lake, Co. Down" there shall be inserted "Montalto Lake, Co. Down".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Byelaws.)

These Byelaws designate a number of waters as rainbow trout waters for the purposes of Byelaw 74 of the Fisheries Consolidated and Amendment Byelaws (Northern Ireland) 1989 which provides that there shall be no close season for angling for rainbow trout in waters so designated.

These Byelaws differ from the previous Byelaws in that Montalto Lake, Co. Down has been designated as a rainbow trout water.
