NURSES, MIDWIVES AND HEALTH VISITORS**Local Training Committees of the National Board (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1990***Made 14th February 1990**Coming into operation 1st April 1990*

The Department of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 9 of the Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979(a) as adapted by Schedule 6 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf after consultation with the Central Council hereby makes the following order:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Local Training Committees of the National Board (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1990 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1990.

(2) In this order unless the context otherwise requires—

“Central Council” means the United Kingdom Central Council for Nursing, Midwifery and Health Visiting;

“the principal order” means the Local Training Committees of the National Board Order (Northern Ireland) 1983(b).

Amendment to the principal order

2. In the Schedule of the principal order there shall be substituted the following list of Colleges of Nursing and Midwifery in Northern Ireland:—

- “1. Northern Area College of Nursing.
2. Southern Area College of Nursing.
3. Western Area College of Nursing.
4. Eastern Area College of Nursing Northside.
5. Eastern Area College of Nursing Southside.
6. Northern Ireland College of Midwifery.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Rules.)

This Order amends the Local Training Committees of the National Board Order (Northern Ireland) 1983 by substituting a new list of Colleges of Nursing and Midwifery in Northern Ireland for the purposes of Article 2 of that Order which relates to the constitution of local Training Committees. The Committees are required to assist the National Board for Nursing, Midwifery and Health Visiting for Northern Ireland in the exercise of its functions in connection with the training of nurses, midwives and health visitors in Northern Ireland.
