JUDGMENTS (ENFORCEMENT)**The Judgment Enforcement Fees (Amendment)
Order (Northern Ireland) 1991**

Made 18th March 1991

Coming into operation 8th April 1991

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 116(1) of the Judicature (Northern Ireland) Act 1978(a), after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Judgment Enforcement Fees (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1991 and shall come into operation on 8th April 1991.

2. In Part I of Schedule 1 to the Judgment Enforcement Fees Order (Northern Ireland) 1989(b):

- (a) for the amount of £7·00 payable in respect of Fee No. 1, there shall be substituted the amount of £10·00; and
- (b) for the amount of £2·00 payable in respect of Fee No. 7, there shall be substituted the amount of £3·00.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Judgment Enforcement Fees (Northern Ireland) Order 1989 so as to:—

- (a) increase the fee on lodging notice of intent to apply for enforcement under rule 6 from £7 to £10, per person served; and
- (b) increase the fee on an application for a search in the register of judgments from £2 to £3, per name searched.
