The Coroners' Courts Fees Order (Northern Ireland) 1991

Made 18th March 1991 Coming into operation 8th April 1991

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 116(1) of the Judicature (Northern Ireland) Act 1978(a), after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Coroners' Courts Fees Order (Northern Ireland) 1991 and shall come into operation on 8th April 1991.

Revocation

2. The Coroners' Courts Fees Order (Northern Ireland) 1982(b) is hereby revoked.

Fee in relation to supply of copy documents

3. There shall be payable, in respect of any copy document furnished under Rule 38(2) of the Coroners (Practice and Procedure) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1963(c), a fee of £1.00 per sheet.
